This equates to 28 people who want to play in a shortened season.

Members voted positively to participate in Summer Sixes competition.

2020 ATHA Hockey Season

Based on Survey Feedback and discussion with Club members present it was **decided NOT to run a shortened winter season for 2020.**

Members discussed the importance of having some form of Hockey activity over the winter period or run the risk of people losing interest.

Following a discussion with members present it was decided to hold 2 Hockey activities for the Hockey Winter Season

1. **Come and try Family Fun Day** : A full day of games and activities for all club members and a come and try event for potential new members (post July 12th reduction in Covid restrictions)

2. **Invitational Carnival** A full day Carnival event with invitations to Mossman and Cairns Clubs. (Aug/Sept)

All events would have to comply with Covid-19 restrictions and health and safety requirements and ability to hold events would be dependant on the Covid restrictions continuing to ease.

Events to be advertised in schools/Community radio/social media and Express Newspaper

Shirley Godfrey will confirm with Hockey Queensland Insurance cover for come and try events.

Shirley Godfrey to also investigate private insurance for one off sporting events.

Commencement of Walking Hockey

Walking Hockey to commence on the 18th of July at 10am for 8 weeks.
Currently 2 teams of 5 confirmed with 2 additional teams of 5 to be confirmed

Junior Hockey

Minkies

Minkies will be running skills sessions and development every **Saturday at 09:30 from July 18th** for 8 weeks.

Summer Sixes

Interest for Summer Sixes is good and the competition will be planned as per usual

ATHA Fees For 2020 (fully financial members)

Minkies : Skills Development Starting on July 18th no change to fees for 2020.
In addition fees will be carried over to 2021

Juniors : Summer sixes free participation
Fees paid will be carried over to 2021

Adults : Summer sixes free participation
Fees will be carried over to 2021

Walking Hockey: Commences July 18th for 8 weeks
HQ insurance will be \$22 (fully financial members already have HQ insurance)
\$50 upfront fee or weekly rate of \$10 per game. (payable before taking the field)

Fair Play Voucher Holders: Situation not yet clear. ATHA will advise when information available.

All players are eligible to receive a refund if unable to play in 2021. If you wish to request a refund please email the ATHA. **Please note this only applies to the ATHA component of fees paid.**

This policy is intended to compensate those who have paid fees up front in 2020. Those who have not paid fees for 2020 will pay fees as usual for Summer Sixes and the 2021 season. If players request a refund and then choose to play full fees will be payable.

Hockey Queensland Fees

HQ has verbally said they will freeze and carry over there fees until the 2021 season or a 70 % refund will be available to members ,but this has yet to be confirmed in writing. ATHA will keep members updated.

The Hockey Australia component of the insurance has not yet been decided by HA. (ATHA will advise as soon as a HA statement is made)

Admin Position

Hayley Fullgrabe has resigned from position
Agreed by all present ATHA still need an admin person to support the club
No longer funded by Hockey Qld ,will have to be funded by club
Hours 5 per week paid on a casual rate
Agreed by all present that Adam Plant will take over the role. Hayley Fullgrabe can provide training to Adam

ATHA Club Financial Position

Fees collected in 2020 were \$12,000
All accounts and bills have been paid so far in 2020
Club general account currently sitting at \$8210.00
Approximate General running costs of the club are \$10,000 per annum
A difficult financial position due to covid-19 but ATHA at the moment are in a better position than other Hockey clubs.
